MEMORIZE

APPLY

How should you *believe* and *live* differently because of this stabilizing truth? Record specific action steps you need to take in response to what God has shown you in His Word. Prayerfully consider **your relationship with God** as well as **your relationships with other people**. Target both your **inner man** (mind/affections/will) and **outer man** (what you do/say).

SHARE

Share what you are learning with God through prayer. Take time to respond to God, praising Him for the things about Him that are always true and asking for His enabling to grow in the areas where the Spirit has convicted you. Also, be sure to share what you are learning with another believer.

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
